

REGION 6 TRAP PROGRAM RULES FOR 2009-2010

1. THE BASIC RULES OF THE State CSHA TRAP program prevail except for the following:

1a. The region 6 fee is \$25.00 per year, payable to CSHA region 6.

2a. The region 6 program runs from October 1st through September 30th each year.

3a. 1. Hours should be submitted to region 6 chairman at least once a month.

2. Hours to be counted from the day of enrollment only. No hours submitted prior to this date will count.

3. Hours for the region 6 program are on a yearly basis, not carried forward as the State does.

4. All hours for the year must be submitted before Oct 10th to allow time to total the hours and to obtain prizes.

4a. Hours may be obtained by riding on trails in Public Parks, State and County Parks, Federal Lands and on Private property.* (*New this year)

5a. Horse shows, Arena riding and training, Parades and Clinics are not to count.

6a. Awards will be presented at the Region 6 Annual Banquet each year. The number of participants in the program will determine the number of awards presented.

Remember, the State and Region 6 TRAP programs are to encourage the use of our trails in Parks and Public lands. Also to encourage riders to go Trail riding and to enjoy your horses and the many beautiful places we have to ride.
