- English / Western: Chair- Sue Leamons, Co –Chair Rhonda Heiner:
 - o Our first Open Show is this coming Sunday, April 29th. I have received seven pre-entries to date and hope that we receive a lot more the day of the show! Everything is on schedule and ready to go. Those folks that have signed up for Saturday afternoon trail set up we will meet at Woodmyst at 5:00 PM. I want to give special thanks to Denise Escover for her help with judge's contracts and other show paperwork and also to Rachelle Lightfoot for her tremendous help with all of the patterns for the show. Patterns are posted the morning of the show and you will have to buy a ticket @ office for warm up trail.
 - o I attended the CSHA Quarterly Meeting this past weekend with Linda Jacobson. Five people attended the E/W committee meeting. We have \$400 in the recovery fund and the State is asking us to promote donations from our club. With show season here, many regions are kicking off fundraisers and holding special events in conjunction with their shows. Much of our discussion revolved around SOC including suggestions of having a flat rate inclusive of all fees, housing Royalty all in one barn, better monitoring to make sure riders truly qualify for SOC, better monitoring of horse substitution rules, establishing SOC protocols and standardizing rules, class lists and other guidelines so they cannot change with each new E/W State Chair elected in to office, SOC venue change (more central California) to involve more state members, sending Top 5 from each Region instead of Top 10 so the show is really the "best of the best" and less of an overall open show.
