Meeting called to order by Linda Jacobsen at 7:05pm.

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by David Escover

New Members/Guest: None present.

Determined Quorum: Quorum was established.

Approval of last month's meeting minutes: Motion made by Virginia Salmina and seconded by Denise Escover.

President's Report: Went to quarterly and will discuss each item within each program report.

Vice President's Report: Dian Forbes stated that she did not have anything to report.
Reminded members to turn in memberships.

Second Vice President's Report: Sandy Casalino had no report.

Treasurer's Report: Virginia Salmina reported balances to membership. A full and complete report was submitted to Secretary for her files. If anyone wishing to see said report may do so by contacting either the Treasurer or the Secretary.

Secretary's Report: Denise requested all program chairs who will be making a report to please submit it to her prior to meeting so she may document it in the meeting minutes.

English/Western Report: Rhonda reported that the judges have been hired for our Aug 28th show. They shall be Jim Edwards, Rail and Nancy Luck Trail, Ranch and Reining. She also reported that all class awards have been obtained through donated items. At this time she requested anyone interested in sponsoring to please contact her. Daily High Point sponsorship levels are \$25, \$50, and \$100.. Lucky J Embroidery stated that it would do a \$100.00 sponsorship with banner. Dazzling Equine Designs also stated they would do a \$100.00

sponsorship with banner.

While Linda was attending the quarterly meetings, the subject of proof of vaccination requirements for showgrounds was brought before the body. It is unclear if Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds requires such documentation. Rhonda volunteered to call fairgrounds to find out.

The deadline for a member's intent to participate at SOC is July 1st. August 10th is the deadline for stalls.

Sue reported that she purchased software and was going to use it for the club. President Linda Jacobsen as well as the membership present, called for a reimbursement to Sue. Sandy Casolino made a motion, Dale provided the second. Reimbursement will be given once a receipt is presented to the Treasurer.

Linda also stated that she spoke with George Yamamoto at quarterly in regards to sanctioning shows during quarterlies. She explained to him that there used to be a rule in the By Laws that stated no shows sanctioning during this time. He said that he agreed and that the rule was erroneously deleted during one of the last revisions of the By Laws. An addendum is being presented at this year's Convention to correct this error.

Sue presented a bill for the English/Western Program postage fees for mailing out premiums. The total was \$204.03 divided three ways between the three participating clubs. Region 6 Portion is \$68.00 (Sixty Eight Dollars). Sandy Casolino motioned to pay, Denise Escover provided the second.

Sue verified that we are having the same program for August show being split with 7CPHC. Exhibitors shall wear same number for the entire weekend. This applies for May as well as Aug show.
